- ❖ Our outward appearance will reflect Christ's life in us. We are the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit. As such, all males and females will dress appropriately not drawing unwanted attention to themselves, distracting the attention of others, nor causing others to have impure thoughts.
- ❖ The Administration at Above and Beyond Academy reserves the right to escort away, from all our events, anyone that would not abide by our Code of Conduct. It is the parent's responsibility to enforce these requests for the building up of all members. If such behaviors continually persist, after being forewarned, your membership in our school may be terminated. Good behavior is expected, bad behavior is dealt with appropriately.
